

Aleurodiscus oakesii (Berk. & Curt.) Pat.



Description:

smooth fungus

Fruiting Body: smooth flat discs up to 1 cm. **Spores:** basidiospores 18-21 x 12-13 μm , ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline.

Diagnostic macroscopic feature: small smooth cream colored discs on bark of living oak or *Ostrya virginiana*

Nutritional Mode: saprobe on bark

Substrate: on trunk bark of living white oak group and *Ostrya virginiana*

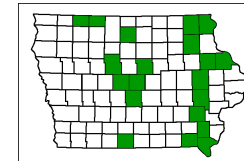
Habitat: oak woods

Fruiting Season: all year
