mushroom

Fruiting Body: cap 5-12 cm; stalk central 6-20 cm long x 0.8-2 cm diameter, enlarged at base. **Spore Print Color:** white. **Spores:** basidiospores 8-10 x 5-6 μm , ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline, blue in Melzer's.

Diagnostic macroscopic feature: context and stalk bruise reddish brown, pinkish veil remnants

Nutritional Mode: ectomycorrhizal

Substrate: on ground

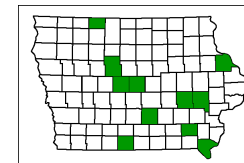
Habitat: deciduous hardwood woodlands
