

Boletus luridiformis Rost.



Description:

bolete

Fruiting Body: cap 5-12 cm; stalk central, 6-10 cm long x 1.3-5 cm diameter; pores 1-3/mm. **Spore Print Color:** olive brown. **Spores:** basidiospores 12-16 x 4.5-6 μ m, smooth, light yellowish brown.

Diagnostic macroscopic feature: distinguished from *B. luridus* which has a reticulate stipe

Nutritional Mode: ectomycorrhizal

Substrate: on ground

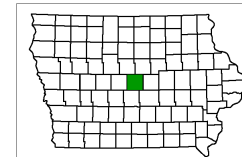
Habitat: deciduous and coniferous woods
