

Boletus pulverulentus Opatowski



Description:

bolete

Fruiting Body: cap 4-8 (12) cm; stalk central, 4-8 cm long x (0.7) 1-2.5 (3) cm diameter; pores 0.5-1/mm, angular. **Spore Print Color:** olive brown.

Spores: basidiospores 11-14 (15) x 4.5-6 μm , ventricose, inequilateral, yellowish brown.

Diagnostic macroscopic feature: instant bluing of flesh and pores with bruising

Nutritional Mode: ectomycorrhizal

Substrate: on ground

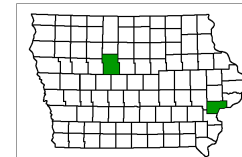
