

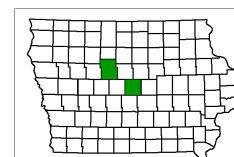
## Hemimycena cucullata (Pers.) Singer

**Description:**

mushroom

**Fruiting Body:** cap 8-20 mm; stalk central, 2-4 (8) cm long x 1-2 mm diameter, equal. **Spore Print**

**Color:** white. **Spores:** basidiospores 8-10 (11) x 4-5  $\mu\text{m}$ , subfusoid, smooth, hyaline, not blue in Melzer's.



not common

**Diagnostic macroscopic feature:** gregarious small white mushrooms on wood

**Diagnostic microscopic feature:** cystidia of gills, stalk and cap are fusoid-ventricose, up to 48  $\mu\text{m}$  long (gills), or 60  $\mu\text{m}$  long (cap and stalk) with resin-encrusted tips

**Nutritional Mode:** saprobe

**Substrate:** on rotten wood

**Habitat:** woodlands

**Fruiting Season:** summer

**Kingdom:** Fungi

**Phylum:** Basidiomycota

**Order:** Agaricales
