ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline, blue in Melzer's.

**Diagnostic macroscopic feature:** dark gray caespitose mushrooms, large for Mycena

**Diagnostic microscopic feature:** gill cystidia very long, up to 110  $\mu$ m (pleurocystidia), or 70  $\mu$ m

(cheilocystidia)

Nutritional Mode: saprobe

Substrate: on logs

Habitat: coniferous and deciduous woods

Fruiting Season: spring
