Mycena from the Greek word for fungus

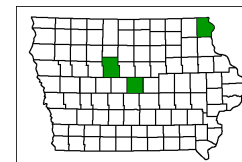


Description:

Fruiting Body: cap (5) 10-20 (25) mm; stalk central, (5) 8-12 (15) cm long x 1-2 mm diameter, equal.

Spore Print Color: white. **Spores:** basidiospores 7-9 x 4-5 μm , ellipsoid, smooth, hyaline, blue in Melzer's.
