Pluteus means a shed, referring to the conical cap; admirabilis means admirable



**Diagnostic macroscopic feature:** small mushroom with bright yellow cap and stalk, free gills that

**Diagnostic microscopic feature:** sterile cells on gill faces  $40-60 \times 12-18$  micro;m, fusoid-ventricose, sometimes with long neck; sterile cells on gill edges  $30-46 \times 10-23$  micro;m,
