

Fruiting Body: cap 4-10 cm; stalk central, 5-8 cm long x 6-12 mm diameter. **Spore Print Color:** white. **Spores:** basidiospores $5 \times 4 \mu m$, subglobose,

smooth, hyaline.

Diagnostic macroscopic feature: large brown mushroom that stains reddish brown on gills and stalk, growing on ground in late summer or fall in oak woods



somewhat common
